Remote Learning Process for Covid Exposure

When students are out due to quarantine, teachers are expected to provide access to daily instruction virtually.

<b>If this occurs, parents should notify the school nurse and the homeroom teacher.</b>	
<b>School Nurse:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Will work with parents regarding necessary expectations for the student's return to school.</li><li>• Will notify the elementary school administrative assistant for attendance purposes.</li><li>• Will notify the classroom teacher to arrange for remote learning.</li></ul>	<b>Homeroom Teacher:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Will contact the parents to discuss remote learning.</li></ul> <p><b>Parents:</b> Please allow 24 hrs. for teacher contact, as the teacher could be absent. If you do not hear from the teacher within this timeframe, please do not hesitate to contact the teacher directly for your child's remote learning plan.</p>

### **Remote Learning**

Depending upon the student's availability, they will attend virtually for the morning meeting, and direct instruction of content, plus any additional time during the day that the teacher deems necessary. The homeroom teacher may add assignments to an online platform such as SeeSaw or Google Classroom. The child may also receive independent work to complete at home. The remote learning schedule and expectations of the student is an agreed upon conversation with the homeroom teacher and the parents. If there is a substitute for the homeroom teacher, there may not be remote learning during the child's absence.

### **Attendance Guidelines**

When a child participates remotely, they will be marked present. Please note that your child might be marked absent initially, depending upon when the school is notified of the quarantine. However, parents may contact Mrs. Mulvaney to correct any absences that have not been updated from absent/excused to present, should this occur.
