Dear Parents,

Just a few reminders to help navigate the what to do if your child has an outstanding COVID test or has symptoms/or a positive test.

Please keep your child home if he/she has an outstanding COVID test. This is true for all tests- if a rapid test was negative, but a PCR test is sent out then your child should remain home until the PCR results come back.

The 5 day quarantine after a positive test or start of symptoms is counted in the following way:

The day symptoms begin or a test is obtained when asymptomatic is day 0. The 5 day count starts the following day.

Your child is able to return to school on the 6th day if symptoms are resolving. He/she must be able to wear a well fitted mask indoors and outdoors for days 6-10.
