

## How to Interpret the Data

- Nationally Normed Survey
- 4-point Scale 1.0 = strongly disagree; 2.0 = disagree;
   3.0= agree; 4.0 = strongly agree
- Number of students in each subset impacts the overall results (central tendency)
- Compare with National Averages and Look for Outliers
- Looking for Score of 2.6 or greater to be above national averages
- Impressed by how many scores Jenkintown had of 3.0 or greater


